Deborah Bordelon:

Enrollment is still looking steady. Met with Sallie, Donna and Jeff.- Fall semester tuition due July 1, Students have options if they are eligible for Financial Aid – August 31 deadline.

Continuing to take a look at spaces around the campus for fall classes.

Meeting with colleges along with President Markwood, Ed Helton, Carole Clerie and Chip Reese.

Ted Laskaris – Budget Reduction Workforce meeting today along with Jeff Davis. Will work on timeline for implementation to represent to ELT. Cleaning up list so it is more accurate.

Website Conversion – Communication will be going out today or tomorrow to all website owners. Conversion will begin shortly. Will work with each area during this conversion.

Jeff Davis:

Cares Act – Shared spreadsheet with ELT – information includes which students can get the Cares Grant funding. Fee funded areas – funds will go back into reserves. No impact on upcoming budget or any proposed budget cuts. ELT recommends to President Markwood for approval and fine for Jeff Davis to submit.

Some offices are now open in Stage 1. Students are coming to campus thinking that offices are open for business. Campus is still closed to the public. Communication needs to be sent out with this message. Ed, Chip and Greg will meet to send out communication stating when the campus will be open again for services.

Craig Burgess:

Theatre Department investigation team met on Tuesday. Dr. Ivan Pulinkala with Kennesaw State University, Ron Williams, Carole Clerie and Craig. Will have a plan in place before individuals are interviewed by the investigator. Contract sent to Jeff for review.

CSU Health Center – Received a message from Piedmont – Issue resolved and will be signing health agreement this week. Facility is located on Blackmon Road – RiverPark facility is closed. Craig will send contract to Gina Sheeks for signature.

Gina Sheeks:

SGA wanting to have a team meeting for students. Gina working with them.

Meeting yesterday with Brook Bowen (USG Systems Office – Legal Affairs) – do not make any changes to Conduct Policy. Any changes will have to be approved by USG. Need to make current policy more transparent for students seeking information – Freedom of Speech. Craig and Gina will work on this and report back to ELT

Todd Reeser: No updates

Ed Helton:

Michael Tullier – New Executive Director - met yesterday with the team.

Return to Campus – Chip Reese – document came back from USG with some changes. Chip sent updated document to ELT for review. Chip requested ELT send recommendation to president for approval. What is the communication plan? Need to work with deans and chairs on what needs to happen in each area – classrooms – how many students can be in the room with social distancing. Personal communication with deans – take them on a tour of modified classrooms. Chip, Ron Williams, Dr. Bordelon – send out the process classrooms. Need to communicate when they can come on campus to look at the spaces. ELT recommends Return to Campus plan to President Markwood. Should not be announced on website until process plan is communicated.

President Markwood:

Call with Chancellor Wrigley yesterday:

1. Senate back in session – budget cuts – Senate version 11%. Did not fund the funding formula for growth. Did approve a number of capital projects – CSU was not in this list. No funds available for merit or salary increases. Waiting for House approval.

2. Freedom of Expression bill Legislators are reviewing.

3. System Review of Campus and Building names – System will conduct a check on each campus for any building with a confederate name.

Minutes June 11 and June 16 approved by all with no changes or additions.

Chip Reese:

Forty-five temp scanners will be distributed around the building – Jeff – cost effective solution. Need to order ASAP. Chip will send information to Greg for 5 Things to Know and Communication plan when scanners are up and ready to go.

There being no other business to discuss, meeting was adjourned at 9:40 a.m.
