Ed Helton:

Leadership Forum – Jessica Drake and Shana Young – This year the forum will be a virtual forum due to COVID-19. Jessica will converse with sponsors and the forum will also include a Q & A with Mr. Blanchard and Ed Helton with Shana Young. Information will also be sent to students as well as CSU alum. Shana is also extending an invitation to Muscogee County School District. Jessica and Ted Laskaris will meet to discuss IT needs.

Return to Campus/Communication Update – Chip Reese and Greg Hudgison – Video by President Markwood will be sent out tomorrow to the campus. Email was sent to ELT to contact their employees notifying them of when they can return to campus during Phase I, Phase II or Phase III. Chip will add Phase IV to the chart which will begin in August. Chip will send revised document with Phase 4. Neil and Valerie from UITS working on Codybot – adding FAQ's regarding Coronavirus and Return to Campus.

Gina Sheeks:

Safety Update – Chief Mark Lott – Partnership with our local community – Return to Campus Task Force planning. Organized protests – Columbus and CSU – minimal disruption. Anticipate more protests in Columbus.

Athletic Camps – Gina, Todd and Craig – met to discuss summer camps – proposing to not host summer camps at CSU. Looked at risks vs rewards – rewards not enough to justify holding summer camps. ELT recommends to President Markwood that no summer camps will be held on the CSU campus this year.

Housing – Currently for fall semester – 96% occupancy – Orientation numbers are up by 280.

Deborah Bordelon:

Enrollment Update – Summer semester – Head Count up by 7%, Credit Hours up by 14.17% - 3,192 student credit hours – up 263 students. Fall semester – Head Count up 158 students, 3.1%, Credit Hours up 2,280, 3.8%. Slight increase in new graduate students. Decline in returning grad students. Increase in applications and acceptances at the grad and undergrad levels. Verification process up from last year at this time.

Fall Academic Calendar – Exploring possibility of ending fall semester at Thanksgiving with finals all online. Talking with representatives from USG Systems Office and the calendar committee. Will include Gina Sheeks, Sarah Secoy, Jennifer Joyner and Jeff Davis at the next

calendar committee meeting. Classes may end on Monday, November 23. Will discuss with Jeff regarding financial aspect. President Markwood would like decision made before fall semester begins.

UITS Update – Ted Laskaris – 80% CSU employees completed the Cybersecurity training. Last year 90% completed the training. Chip and Neil working on Codybot. Meeting next week with STAMAT. Working with Mariko – mind craft PROWL. Cleaning up generic accounts. Touchnet top priority.

Budget Reduction Taskforce committee – Working on completing report on the organizational design for Shared Services model. Plan to deliver initial recommendation to ELT next week.

Rocky Kettering:

Investment Committee – Tim Money wants to have a face to face meeting. CSU cannot conduct any face to face meeting at this time – must be a virtual meeting.

Craig Burgess:

Working with Ric Barrow on Risk Management Practices for Department of Administrative Services.

President Markwood:

Scheduled meeting with the Chancellor tomorrow at 3:00. Waiting for legislators to go back into session to give us our budget. Had a meeting yesterday with managers with the Bradley Turner Foundation.
