Deborah Bordelon:

Enrollment Update – Summer semester – Head Count up by 8%, Credit Hours up by 14.86%. Fall semester – Head Count up by 3%, Credit Hours up by 3.76%.

Academic Calendar – proposed adjustments for fall including commencement. Meeting next week – face to face classes concluding before Thanksgiving – finals would be online. Need to look at contingency plan meals, dorm rooms – possibly reduce rates up front.

Jeff Davis:

Budget Update – Governors recently indicated an 11% reduction in appropriations instead of 14% = 1.4M in savings. 2.4M gap rather than 3.8M. Nothing is definite until legislators go back into session and approve the budget.

Bookstore – Barnes Noble taking over the CSU bookstore on July 1.

Deborah Bordelon:

Budget Reduction Taskforce – Concept around Shared Services – will submit plan to ELT next Tuesday, June 9.

Gina Sheeks:

Phone call yesterday with Joyce Jones, USG Systems office, and VPs from the various institutions – twitter groups develop own twitter sites – UGA Safe Space – identifying African American males associated with sexual assaults on campus.

Todd Reeser:

Thirteen of our fourteen athletic teams had a GPA of 3.0 and better. Thirty four athletes carried a GPA of 4.0.
